Emergency Access Routes	
<p>All emergency vehicles will access the playing fields via Elmley Road and through the gates by the children's playground. The lane and area around the gate must be kept clear and room allowed for access of an emergency vehicle. Access down to the pitch must also be kept clear if access to the pitch is required.</p> <p>A person should be pre-positioned at the junction on Elmley Road to direct emergency vehicles to the playing fields. A person should also ensure access is clear near the gate and children's play area at all times.</p> <p>If the Midland Air Ambulance is required on site please follow the directions of any emergency crew member already on scene.</p>

What to expect when you dial 999 (or112)				
You will be asked the following questions:				
Ask for an ambulance	Is the patient breathing?	What address are you calling from	What number are you calling from (in case you get cut off)	What is the reason for your call?

Not all calls will require a traditional ambulance to be sent. By answering all the questions clearly the operator will be able to best examine the situation and respond appropriately with help, guidance and support.
